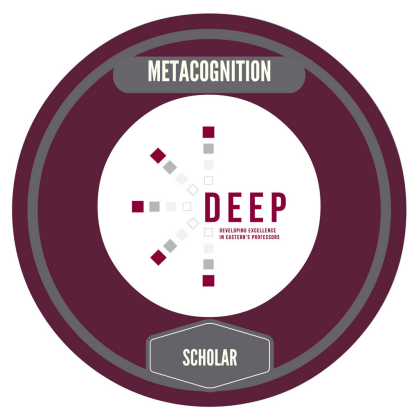

DEEP'S ORGANIZATION

Each DEEP course involves four levels that contain materials and assignments for successful completion. Each level calls for an intensified engagement in the pedagogical topic by learning outcomes and cognitive process dimensions outlined in the Revised Bloom's Taxonomy.

1. Learner
2. Practitioner
3. Advocate
4. Scholar

With each level completed, the faculty member will attain new knowledge as well as documentation of completion. Each level completed strengthens the participants promotion, tenure, and evaluation portfolio. Faculty are encouraged to complete as many or as few levels that are relevant to them and their work .

BENEFITS TO FACULTY

Self-Paced

Progression through each level and course is up to the faculty member or department. However, progress is tracked and learners are encouraged to advance through the system.
